### **General Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Ron Hooper. Mohave Sportswomen's next range day is scheduled for July 16, 2016 from 9 to 11 am. Shooting will occur first, with classroom lecture to follow. Topics will include gun cleaning and choice of weapons for use. Meeting closed at 6:04.

### **Board Meeting**

The Board Meeting was called to order at 6:04 pm. The June meeting minutes were read and approved. Steve gave the financial report. As of June 30, 2016, the Club had a total of \$25,708 in cash with a monthly income of \$6,985.26. The greatest income sources for the month were membership at \$1,855, CTC at \$1,290, \$800 in fees from Mohave Greens, and non-member fees at \$650. The remainder of the income is from the numerous monthly shooting events.

Major expenses included salaries at \$3,639, range upkeep at \$342, and payroll taxes at \$324. The rest of the expenses were

smaller and for such items as utilities and range supplies. A motion was made and passed to accept the treasurer's report.

George Yurish gave the range officer's report: there were 1,081 shooters for the month (984 rifle/pistol and 97 shotgun). There were 30 new members and 56 renewals. Total membership stands at 1,880.

The golf cart discussion was continued from the June meeting. The Board and those in attendance had a lively discussion on whether to purchase a golf cart for rent on the range. It would be rented to people for use on the rifle ranges. President Hooper called for a motion to purchase a cart. None was made - so the proposal died for lack of support.

Jim Jett made a motion to have the cart that was obtained as surplus from the Game and Fish Department be made operational. Dave Vance mentioned that the cart would not run because of fuel problems. The motion was made, seconded and passed. Dave said he would repair.

The president called for a motion to purchase steel roofing for Bay 8. The motion was for \$2,100 to purchase steel. Ron mentioned he would order the roofing in the next few days.

Ron informed the Board that there was an opportunity to have the road between the Club House and the CTC covered with tailings from local road repaving construction. McCormick Construction had contacted Ron to inquire if the tailings could be stored on the range, they would do the road work. Ron mentioned he had contacted the Game and Fish about the proposal and would be meeting with McCormick on Friday, July 14, 2016 to discuss project.

There was a brief discussion on selling advertising space at the range. We have had some requests to do so. Discussion was tabled until the August meeting for further discussion.

Don Martin discussed the recent Fishing for Smiles kids' fishing event. He expressed concern about the lack of attendance at the

event by the Mohave Sportsman Club members - particularly the Board of Directors. He asked the Board to make clear to all involved the level of involvement Mohave Sportsman Club would like to have in the future with this event.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to adjourn, which occurred at 7:40 pm.
