General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Vice President Bill Mc Cune. A call was made to President Ron Hooper to join in the discussion.

Board Meeting

The Board meeting was called to order at 6:08 pm. There was not a meeting in the month of September as we did not have FIVE people to have a Quorum.

George Yurish gave the range officer's report.

He stated that in the month of September, we had an increase of 106 shooters over the period in August.

Waters bills should be lower as new leaking faucet and a shut off valve were replaced and a busted water hose has been replaced.

The last of the raffle tickets were sold and Rad Green drew the winning ticket. George called the person and gave him the rifle.

Total monthly usage was 1,436. Rifle, Pistol and Archery Shooters: 1,381. CTC Shooters 55. New memberships were 41 and 68 renewals. Total memberships stands at 2,538.

Government Liaison Report

Terry informed us about the latest news about the lion hunting and I put up a red poster in the range office with that information. I spoke about starting a petition drive here at the club for member to sign and give to Terry at the time for him to use it. We need to start informing the members on this thing as it comes up.
