General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm by President Ron Hooper.

The Mohave Sportswomen's next range day is scheduled for October 16, 2016 at the Club House and Bay 3. They will be discussing the use of shotguns.

There were questions regarding sporting clay field unavailability when archery is having a meet. The outcome was that Dave Vance and Taco Esquibel are coordinating so no potential conflicts occur. It is up to the rest of the range users to stay informed and know what is happening

Board Meeting

The Board Meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm. The August meeting minutes were read and approved. There were no September meeting notes because there was no quorum in September.

Steve Zoelle gave the financial report. As of September 30, 2016, the club had on hand \$26, 578.70. Total income for September was \$10,444 and total expenses for the month were \$7,099. Net income was \$3,293. Major income was from membership at \$4,830, non-member fees at \$930, clay target center at \$591, and

reimbursement from the Game and Fish at \$2,000. Expenses were, salaries \$3,794, Range upkeep \$676, and utilities at \$900.

Both the minutes and financial report motion were approved though a motion and vote.

George Yurish gave the range officer's report:

- Raffle ticket sales for the current raffle are slow. To date 43 have sold leaving 57.

- Ed Lewis donated a shotgun reloader to be given to a shotgun shooting youth.

- Ben Moyer of Bank Street Guns has sent us \$1,720 in total for the dual membership program. This represents 43 new members.

- The new metal roof on bay 8 was finished on September 7. The roof coating on bays 9&10. This will be completed soon.

- There were 1,348 shooters for the month (1199 rifle/pistol and 149 shotgun). There were 52 new members and 52 renewals. Total membership stands at 1,980.

The rest of the meeting was dedicated to reviewing the proposed bylaw changes. The board approved a total of a 17 changes/additions which will be forwarded to the membership for a vote.
