General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Ron Hooper.

-No comments.

Board Meeting

The Board Meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm. The June meeting minutes were read. A motion to approve was made by Terry Kirkum , seconded by Jim Jett. The motion carried.

-*Steve Zoelle* gave the financial report. As of October 31, 2017, the club had on hand \$18,599. Major income for June included \$6,399 from membership dues, \$3,000 from law enforcement fees, \$2,030 from non-member fees, and \$793 from the shotgun range. Total income for the month was \$14,449.

Major costs were, \$4,408 for salaries, insurance at \$2,754, range improvements at \$1,264, and \$900 for utilities. Total expenses were \$11,853. This resulted in a net gain of \$1,950.

Jim Merritt made a motion, seconded by Bill McCune, to accept financial report. The motion was approved.

George Yurish gave the range officer's report:

-The month of October had an increase of 153 shooters over September.

-Our water bill should be even lower next month because we found another leak and that has been taken care of. It was the shut off valves for the tree drip irrigation system.

-Bank Street Guns signed up 7 new members.

-The shirts for the range came in two weeks ago and have been selling very well. They all have pockets and sell for \$12.

-One of our life members, Tim Momjian, welded some of the damaged targets from the 500 meter range. Thanks Tim.

-Our old range officer, Dan Leininger, stayed for a month and installed a new computer in the range office.

-Total monthly usage was 1,589. Rifle, archery and pistol shooters totaled 1,489 with 100 shotgunners. New memberships were 66 with 129 renewals. Total membership stands at 2,604.

Board Actions.

-A motion was made by Steve Zeolle, seconded by Bill McCuen to give an award to Howard Lawrence Motion passed.

-We have identified 100 bad boundary signs around the range property line. Ron said he would talk to AG&F about new ones.

A motion to send a letter was made by Jim Jett and seconded by Terry Kirkum. Motion passed.

-Terry discussed the fact that the Humane Society wants to ban hunting in Arizona. We need to oppose the state-wide initiative petition on lion hunting.

-The Board made a motion to sell lead from the harvest at the shot gun range at 0.75/lb with a limit of 250 pounds per month. It was passed.

-A motion was made to adjourn by Steve Zeolle, seconded by Jim Merritt and was passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:09 pm.
