General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Ron Hooper.

Board Meeting

The Board Meeting was called to order at 6:11 pm. The February meeting minutes were read. A motion was made by Jim Merritt, seconded by Ken Coombs, and the minutes were approved.

-*Steve Zoelle* gave the financial report. As of February 28, 2017, the club had on hand \$32,295. Major income was from membership at \$5,030, Antelope Eaters at \$5,691, Law Enforcement fees at \$1,500, non-member fees at \$1,430, and clay target center at \$1,337. Major expenses were, Antelope Eaters at \$5,754, salaries \$3,442, range upkeep at \$983 range

supplies at \$436, and utilities at \$1,253. Net income for the month was \$3,514.

Ken Coombs made a motion, seconded by Bill McCune, to accept financial report. The motion was approved.

George Yurish gave the range officer's report:

-February total usage was 1,380. Rifle and pistol shooters totaled 1,272 with 112 shotgunners. New memberships were 49 with 66 renewals. Total membership stands at 2,242. Use was 382 more than in January.

-The Month of February had nothing new or exciting happened on the Range except the old Dodge Truck died. The radiator was leaking, fuel injector cleaner was put in the gas for the engine and that didn't work. The pulley for the power steering was lost and new tires are needed. The truck was donated to us 5 or 6 years ago and we don't think we have a title.

Board Actions.

-An overview of the Antelope Eaters event was given. Gross income for the event was \$11,445, costs were \$5,754 giving a net income of \$5,691. All that volunteered commented they had a good time helping out. No complaints were received from changing the raffle and event times at this year's event.

-Ken Coombs gave an overview of the Club's draft sign policy. We are just waiting for Game and Fish to give the go ahead to our placing of signs.

-The Board discussed the idea of approving \$2,000 for the 2018 Antelope Eaters event. Doing so will allow the Club to take advantage of sales during the year and money to potentially purchase firearms from manufactures. A motion was made by Ken Coombs to approve the \$2,000, seconded by Jim Jett and approved.

Ken Coombs made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Terry Kirkum. Motion passed. Adjournment occurred at 7:35pm.
