General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Ron Hooper.

-Terry spoke about the possibility increasing archery permits. Game and Fish have been conducting fish releases statewide. He is working with Cabela's to get sponsorships for our events.

-Jim Jett mentioned that Ruger has done a voluntary recall of the new Mark IV .22 pistol. There is a problem with the location of the safety.

Board Meeting

The Board Meeting was called to order at 6:08 pm. The May meeting minutes were found to be incomplete so were not read. They will be read and approved at the July meeting

-*Steve Zoelle* gave the financial report. As of May 31, 2017, the club had on hand \$29,264. Major income for May included \$3,610 from membership dues, \$3,600 for Fishing for Smiles, \$1,130 from non-member fees \$666 from the shotgun range, \$420 from raffle sales. Total income for the month was \$4,745.

Major costs were, \$4,480 for salaries, range upkeep at \$1,873, \$1,003 for workers comp insurance, \$1,911 for a purchase of a table at the Friends of the NRA Banquet and \$626 for utilities.

Total expenses were \$12,135. This resulted in a net loss of \$7,390.

Jim Merritt made a motion, seconded by Jim Jett, to accept financial report. The motion was approved.

George Yurish gave the range officer's report:

-The month of May had a lot of good shooting days and we had 301 more shooter than in April. We had our annual Bonsai shoot on Saturday May 13. There was a good turnout with their machine guns, rifles and pistols. The only thing we had to watch for was for one or two people shooting at the ground 15 feet in front of them so they could take videos of the kicking up dirt. This won't happen again.

I want to thank all the range officer, board members and others that volunteered their time that day to help with the event.

We had our FRNA dinner on May 27th. Unlike last year, we did not win an extra gun for our raffle. We received a Kimber Pro carry 45 ACP for our next two gun raffle to be included with the Ruger Precision Rifle.

-Total usage was 1,673. Rifle, archery and pistol shooters totaled 1,555 with 118 shotgunners. New memberships were 38 with 69 renewals. Total membership stands at 2,402.

Board Actions.

-The Board accepted the sign policy given by Ken Coombs. Ken will begin meeting with individuals and companies to sale signs.

-George gave an overview the newspaper add we will purchase from Bank Street Guns.

-A new raffle was discussed. It was decided to conduct another two gun event. It will include the Ruger Precision Rifle and the

Kimber Pro just acquired. A motion was made by Jim J. seconded by Ken C. to sell 150 \$20 tickets. Motion passed.

-Jim Jett agreed to take the lead for the Board to head the Bylaw committee.

-Keith Bishop has agreed to take the vacant Director at Large position. A motion was made Jim M., seconded by Jim J. to place Keith on the Board. Motion passed.

-Steve Zoelle discussed a bee problem at the Cowboy range. There is an active hive under the conex. A motion was made by Terry K. seconded by Ken C. to spend up to \$250 to get an extermination if necessary. Motion passed.

-A motion was made to adjourn by Jim J., seconded by Terry K. and was passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:39pm.
